CHAPARRAL METROPOLITAN DISTRICT – Pool Rules and Regulations

POOL HOURS – Regular hours are from 10 AM to 8 PM Memorial Day through Labor Day. The pool may be closed due to inclement weather at the sole discretion of the lifeguard and/or the CMD manager.

ACCESS – Chapparal homeowners, and their guests, must have their access code to enter the pool area. Sign in with the pool staff as you arrive. Pool staff may periodically validate authorization through a resident list provided by the CMD manager.

RULES

- 1. Always obey the lifeguard staff.
- 2. Proper swim attire required swimsuits only. Children not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper while in the pools. NO PLASTICE DIAPERS are permitted.
- 3. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult 17 or older to enter the pool area. Children 9-12 may be unaccompanied if they pass a swimming proficiency test administered by the lifeguards. Anyone who cannot demonstrate proficient swimming ability must be in direct contact with an adult while in the pool even when wearing appropriate safety flotation devices (life jacket or puddle jumper).
- 4. Floating toys, rafts, rings, tubes and boards are allowed if not detrimental to safety but may be prohibited at the discretion of the lifeguards. Hard balls, such as tennis balls and footballs, are not permitted in the pool area.
- 5. No GLASS CONTAINERS in or around the fenced pool area.
- 6. No diving in shallow areas or dunking others.
- 7. No hanging on lane lines or depth dividers.
- 8. No pushing, running, shouting or other rowdiness in or around the pool area including the showers and restroom area.
- 9. Foul, abusive, or excessively loud language will not be permitted.
- 10. Music must be played at an appropriate volume and not be offensive to others. Discretion of the lifeguards.
- 11. No gum/ food is permitted in or near the swimming pool. Trash must be disposed of in waste receptacles.
- 12. Animals are not allowed in the pool area or to be tethered unattended at any time.
- 13. Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc. are not permitted in the pool area. Roller blades and wheelies must be removed before entering the pool area.
- 14. During regular pool hours, the pool will be cleared on even hours for a 10-minute period. (Safety Break). Safety Break 11:50-12:00

Adults can swim with kids 3 years and under. 17 years and younger are asked to exit the pool.

15. Drugs are not permitted on the premises. Violations may result in suspension of pool privileges. These products include, but are not limited to vapes, marijuana, e-cigarettes, smoking and/or tobacco products.

DIVING BOARD

- 1. Dive straight off the diving board. To avoid collisions, swim directly to the edge and exit using the ladder.
- 2. One bounce allowed. Don't swim under the diving board or hang on the board.
- 3. Flips and back dives are permitted.

WADER POOL – The wader pool is for the use of children 6 yrs. and under. NO LIFEGUARD is provided for the wader pool. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Violations of the pool rules could result in the offender being asked to leave the pool area for the rest of the day. Pool privileges may be suspended for up to 48 hours by the lifeguards and for longer periods by the pool manager or Board of Directors.
