May 25th through September 15th, 10:00 am to 8:00 pm
(Dates and times may vary based on weather)

Pool access or replacement keys: Pool and Grand Hall access keys are available at the Grand Hall. Replacement keys are \$25.00 each with a max of one key fob and one key card per household. Please contact the Community Manager by emailing tiffany.averett@advancehoa.com or by calling (303) 482-2213 x235. Please report lost keys immediately to Advance HOA Management so they can be de-activated and not fall into the hands of non-residents. Please give found keys to the Community Manager at the Grand Hall so she may return it to its owner.

Authorization Access: Any homeowner who is delinquent in their monthly assessment will **not** be granted access to the pool and Grand Hall. Unfortunately, if you are renting and the owner of the address is delinquent, you will not be able to access the pool until the account is brought into a zero (\$0.00) balance or other arrangements have been made with the Idyllwilde Board of Directors.

POOL RULES

-
- Members must present Pool Access Card to enter pool facility.
 - Unless otherwise posted no swimming when a Lifeguard is not on duty.
 - Guests must be accompanied to the pool facility by the inviting member, or one of his or her immediate family members entitled to pool privileges.
 - Members who are 18 years old and above are permitted to have up to six (6) guests per household accompanying them. However, members between the ages of 12 and 18 are restricted to a maximum of two (2) guests per household accompanying them.
 - Children 12 and under must always be accompanied by a parent, or a parent's hired care provider at all times.
 - No smoking or vaping is permitted in pool or the pool area.
 - Public intoxication through use of alcohol, illicit drugs, or any marijuana-based products while an owner or their guest is in the pool or pool area, is strictly prohibited.
 - No glass or breakable containers allowed in or around pool area.
 - No beverages or food is allowed in the pool. Food and non-alcoholic drink are allowed on the deck area and around the pool.
 - No horseplay, running, or excessive noise. No diving is allowed.
 - No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, or non-pool equipment allowed in the pool area.
 - No pets allowed in pool area, with the exception for registered service pets.
 - Lifeguards shall take 10-minute break every two hours on the hour. During this time, it is required for everyone to exit the pool.
 - Access to the pool will be temporarily revoked for the remainder of the day for individuals who receive three (3) warnings for disrupting the operations of the pool and/or pool staff.
 - No solicitation of any kind of business is permitted in or around the pool area.
 - Raft use and inflatables will be at the discretion of the lifeguards.
 - The pool facilities shall be used by persons at their own risk.

Please be a good neighbor:

1. Turn off showers after use.
2. Parents, kindly ensure that you supervise your children while they are in the restrooms.
3. To maintain the security of the premises and restrict access to authorized residents and their guests only, we strictly prohibit tailgating.
4. We kindly request that you refrain from lending your access cards/fobs to others or propping the gate open. The pool is an exclusive amenity for Idyllwilde homeowners, funded through your dues. It is not intended for public use or for the surrounding communities. Your cooperation is appreciated in maintaining the privacy and enjoyment of this facility for the rightful residents.

POOL USE AFTER HOURS IS CONSIDERED TRESPASSING AND VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED.
